Chrysalis by Chuck McKenzie

Consciousness hit him like a hammer. He convulsed, thrashing against silk-lined pine, dislodging the casket lid. Soft, cool soil gushed into his eyes and mouth, and with it came an overwhelming sense of belonging, of *oneness*; the soil, the rocks and himself, each crawling with life yet lifeless, unfettered by the wretched need to scratch, rub, defecate or breathe. No tics, aches or weariness; just the comforting throb of the earth, the whispering cycles of the soil. Joy overwhelmed him. He tried to cry out, but his desiccated lungs produced only a low moan.

He lay still for a while. Then, driven by an urge to immerse himself completely in the soil, he pushed aside the coffin lid and swam upwards, open-mouthed, allowing the deep, rich loam to penetrate and fill him.

Moments later he erupted from the earth and lay trembling upon the ground. So *hot*. So bright. He clawed at the sunbaked mud with rotting fingers, moaning desperately. *Please! Let me back in where it's cool and safe...*

But the ground refused to soften.

Eventually, he clambered to his feet and stood staring miserably at the world around him. Living things scuttled among the headstones and grasses, slithering between leaves and branches, whirring overhead and underfoot. The very air *pulsed* with life. He moaned again. *Why am I here?*

Voices drifted between the tombs. The world pressed in upon him, and something inside suddenly snapped. He began to run, long, staggering strides propelling him jerkily across the graveyard. He stumbled over a weed-covered drain and fell, bursting out between plots and diving onto a gravel-lined path. He lay still for a moment, savouring the sensation of cold stone against his ruined face.

Someone screamed.

He raised his head. Further up the path stood a woman, her face pale, a crumpled bouquet of flowers clutched between trembling hands. She stared at him, delicate veins pulsing in her throat, muscles twitching beneath her skin.

Self-pity dissolved away.

You poor, wretched creature. Your every moment must be agony. The endless anticipation of bodily failure, of aneurysm, blindness, senility, entombing you forever in a cell of living flesh. If I could do something, anything, to relieve your suffering -

And abruptly, he understood.

He staggered to his feet, and she turned and fled. He pursued her, a new sense of purpose lending him speed.

Wait! Come back! Let me help you!

She darted off the path, stumbling between ancient crypts. He quickened his pace. Then her foot twisted beneath her, and she fell.

He was upon her in a moment, shuddering in revulsion as he caressed her warm flesh, covering her mouth, stifling her cries.

This is my purpose: to take you to a better place. That which I devour will be purified. The rest will rise again to join me in my task...

He bit into her neck, tore, chewed and bit again, moaning rapturously between mouthfuls. And she moaned too, for a while.

Reviews

Pawn of Prophecy by **David Eddings**, reviewed by Stuart Wark

Eddings is one the biggest fantasy writers in the world today, and his first novel in the genre was Pawn of Prophecy. It was the first of five books that now compose the Belgariad series. Pawn of Prophecy commences with a prologue that provides a brief history of seven gods, and the events that resulted in war amongst the deities. Chapter one begins with a boy named Garion, and his Aunt Pol, who both live on a rural farm. Eddings establishes the world that surrounds Garion very well. While his life appears very average, he is, not unexpectedly, soon involved in mystery and intrigue. Garion is surrounded by a developing cast of characters who initially appear quite normal and real, yet they are slowly revealed as being much more than that.

Eddings' writing in Pawn of Prophecy is filled with humour, and his dialogues can be genuinely funny at times. Unlike some other fantasy authors, Eddings does not appear to take his creations too seriously, and this enables him to develop the storyline well. One of Eddings' gifts is the ability to write memorable characters. Many of the central personalities like Garion are very likable, while others such as Aunt Pol. are perhaps less amiable but still fascinating. However, a criticism of this book, and indeed entire series, is the fact that Eddings does not appear able to successfully portray true malevolence. The presentation of the 'enemy' within the novel is often quite clichéd, and lacking in any real sense of true evil.

I first read Pawn of Prophecy as a teenager about two decades ago, and I can still remember the sheer enjoyment these books provided, and the frustration of waiting months and months until the next novel was released. It was therefore with some trepidation that I decided to re-read the series to see if it stood up to the test of time. It now seems quite popular to criticise Eddings as being formulaic and derivative. Some reviewers seem to delight in panning Eddings' novels as being hackneyed and passé.

Happily, I enjoyed returning to Garion and his journey through life as much now as I did in the 80s. While Eddings is still writing fantasy books, it is my belief that his best work was during the 80s and 90s, and Pawn of Prophecy underlines why he is considered one of the best writers in the genre. The Belgariad is appropriately considered one of the seminal works of fantasy, and it should be mandatory reading for all fans.

Speculation on Science Future: In the The Spike, Damien Broderick tries to take us on a tour of that undiscovered country, the future. The book defines this as being also an undiscoverable country as it lies beyond that point where extrapolations of the rate of progress of present day technologies to the lifestyles of the future must inevitably break down. A range of technologies are discussed in the sections of this book. What they have in common is that each has a rate of progress / development that seems to be accelerating as time goes forward. He does a fairly comprehensive job of charting what 'progress' in each of these fields might ultimately lead to, economically, technologically and to the human societies that may be created in the wake of the 'Spike', when Science may appear to be magic and 'God-like' powers a daily reality. A difficult read, but worth sticking with, as it is a Science Fiction Literate account. The same book written in isolation of an understanding of SF would need to be very much thicker, to explain concepts and situations not encountered in 'Mundane' writing. It also features multiple references to the opinions and observations of David Bofinger, a Sydney fan known to Sydney Futurian meetings.

Dune by Frank Herbert, reviewed by Dan

Dune is an epic fantasy story, written as literary science fiction. In the world of the far future, all thinking machines have been outlawed, and technology is highly restricted. Human computers, mentats, are trained from birth to make complex calculations. The Bene Gesserit are an understated power force, with their extreme body control and millenia long breeding program to select for desirable human traits. Humans are moved through space by the Spacing Guild's navigators, who use the spice to assist in moving their Heighliners through space.

Dune is a story of revenge, hope and fate. There is the constant cycle of hatred and revenge of one Great House against another, shown by Baron Harkonnen plotting the downfall of House Atreides as part of an emnity that started thousands of years earlier. The book focuses on Paul Atreides, son of the Duke, and fated to become the Kwisatch Haderach, the culmination of the Bene Gesserit breeding program. He can forsee the future of constant war and hopes that he, and humanity, can avoid that fate.

First published in 1965, Dune stands the test of time and the comments on society in it are as relevent today as they were when it was first written. This is a book to read when you want to be challenged in your thinking and is recommended reading for all fans of science fiction.
