“Hammer of God” Book 3 of Godspeaker Series by Karen Miller

The Godspeaker Series tells the story of two queens. One was born a slave and rose to be queen of a kingdom. She rules with magic and cruelty and is already ancient. The other, a

young woman, came to rule by chance. She is fearless in battle and loved by her people. In this third book, Hammer of God, the old queen Hekatof Mijakand the young queen Rhian

of Ethrea meet and a great battle ensues. But much, much more is in this powerful book, including the lives of the henchmen and people of both nations and the powerful magic in these lands.

Do read this series as a whole if possible as there are many characters and lots of interesting detail in each of these books. Hammer of God is well written and flows smoothly. I enjoyed reading it and found it a fitting conclusion to the Godspeaker Series.

***Artemis Fowl and the Time Paradox* by Eoin Colfer, reviewed by Liam**

The sixth book in the Artemis Fowl series by Eoin Colfer stars Artemis with a very serious problem; his mother is dying from a mysterious disease that feeds on magic. The only known cure was an extinct lemur. However, the last known specimen was sentenced to death by Artemis Fowl himself. So what does not so little Arty do? Why, what every slightly evil genius does! Go back in time to steal the lemur from his ten-year old self!

Eoin has done a great job explaining the ending in his Artemis Fowl and the Lost Colony in this book, with the twin brothers being diabolical little geniuses in their own right and showing how Artemis copes with his parent’s knowledge of the fairy underworld.

Very good plot line, though if the ending can give Artemis a headache it is sure to leave you thoroughly confused. The tricks the young Artemis sets against his future self are marvellous and the supreme diabolical evil enemy at the end is quite surprising.

All in all, a good book with the best Eoin Colfer could put in it, nice for those who have a few Artemis Fowl books and for young teenagers.

***Barnaby Grimes Curse of the Night Wolf* by Paul Stewart and Chris Stewart,**

Curse of the Night Wolf is a faux Victorian adventure novel set in a city where “there are a thousand and one ways to meet your end”. It’s an exciting new story, darkly colourful and brimming with action, by the creators of The Edge Chronicles and the Far-Flung Adventures series.

Barnaby Grimes is a tick-tock lad – a delivery boy in a Dickensian city, full of grime, poverty and exploitation. Barnaby “highstacks” his way around the city, in search for commissions and mystery. Following the strange disappearance of his good friend Old Benjamin, Barnaby unwittingly gets caught in a nefarious plot involving the city’s poor and sickly members, mad science, curious potions, and fashion for high society. Why are people disappearing? Where did the huge wolf-like beast haunting the city’s rooftops come from? Who’s behind it all? Will the demand for the exquisite Westphalian trim ever subside?

The plot is easy to follow, the twists and turns, although not entirely unpredictable, are very enjoyable nonetheless. Curse of the Night Wolf is reminiscent of Roald Dahl’s often bizarre, macabre stories, enriched by Barnaby’s colourful descriptions of places and events. Each chapter ends with a hook, making the book very hard to put down, for young and more mature readers alike.

The black and white Victorian-style ink illustrations, accompanying the most striking scenes in each chapter, are a gorgeous complement to the text, making the quirky, caricatured characters and the city come to life.

Readers will not rest until the curious mystery at the heart of the story has been solved, with a very satisfying twist!

***Three Dragon Ante* the card game, reviewed by Dan**

Three Dragon Ante is an easy game to learn, but one with complex tactics. The goal: to be the last person left with gold pieces in their hoard (gold pieces not included). Gameplay is broken up into gambits, which involve playing an ante, then a ‘flight’, usually of 3 dragon cards (there are very few non dragons in the deck). Each dragon colour has its own special ability, as does each of the mortals. The person with the highest strength ‘flight’ wins the gambit and importantly, all the coins in the ante. The game can be played by 2 people, although it is best with 3 or more (max 6). Length of game will vary depending on number of players, but can be as short as 10 minutes, or up to an hour.

Here, Erika and Bradley begin an affair which is ultimately doomed to fail. At the same time, Vincent attempts an espionage coup which ends in disaster for himself and Bradley. Both men are expelled from China, and are based in Canberra, where Vincent is confined to the ASIS Registry: the 'memory room' of the book's title. This is the year of Star Wars, and the final phase of the Cold War. Erika, also returning to Australia, becomes a television journalist, and enjoys a period of national prominence. The fantasies of youth have become reality for Erika and Vincent, and lead to a tragic climax for them both. It is left to Bradley, who inherits Vincent's diaries, to contemplate their fate. Although *THE MEMORY ROOM* deals with espionage, its aims go far beyond those of a thriller. A psychological study of a brilliant but eccentric secret intelligence operative, it is also an exploration of the mystical nature of secrecy itself, and of the consequences of a shared obsession. **TP \$32.95**
