Book Reviews

***Blood Ties* by Pamela Freeman, reviewed by Josephine Crowley and Naomi Cooke**

This fantasy book is the story of Bramble and Ash and their journey through life. Bramble is a wilful young woman; spending her youth amidst a staid rural community and this is the story of her breaking free. Bramble's racial heritage comes from the gypsy-like race called Travellers, and it is in the process of travelling that she is most herself. Her story is a beautiful one of challenge and adversity. She has a remarkable affinity with animals, and some exciting horse races akin to the best of Banjo Paterson are scattered throughout the book. Ash, also a Traveller, is a young man finding his place in the world. His uncanny ability to communicate with the ghosts of the dead lead him to an apprenticeship with the revered Stone Caster. His learning of the mysteries of future-telling leads him on a journey which eventually intersects with Bramble's.

The narrative structure of 'Blood Ties' begins quite disjointedly. Peripheral characters dominate the early chapters, and it is not until well into the novel that the story comes together. This is probably because this is the first of a trilogy, and significant time is spent establishing the world of 'The Casting' trilogy. Despite this slow beginning, the novel is remarkably well written, and draws the reader into the story with a compulsive energy.

Freeman paints a vivid picture of life in the villages: of people thatching houses, breaking in horses, rearing families, of grasses growing and seasons changing. Perhaps the detailed descriptions are inspired by her academic research. She is an Australian writer with an established career in children's books, and this, her first adult novel, began as part of her Doctorate of Creative Arts at University of Technology, Sydney. 'Blood Ties' is an engaging new fantasy novel. It is exciting to see Australian writers of this quality emerging. Book Two of the trilogy is eagerly awaited.

When Raheinan Special Forces captain Gillaine Davre wakes up 342 years in the future and a goddess in the seeming space of 'a couple of unconscious hours', she discovers that life has just become more complicated. Things to do: 1. Find out how she ended up goddess, 2. Hide her real identity from the people on the station, 3. Survive the seductive advances of one Admiral Mack Makarian, and 4. Save the Khalain people... again!

This is a fun light weight space opera / romantic novel. If you enjoyed Anne McCaffrey's space opera novels (The Rowan, Crystal Singer, The Ship that Sang etc), then you will enjoy this story.

Bernard Cornwell's epic retelling of the King Arthur legend combines intriguing characters and beautifully choreographed battle scenes with brutal realism and thoroughly researched historical detail, making this trilogy a compulsive read. The Winter King, the first book in the trilogy, chronicles the rise of Arthur. The story is narrated by Derfel, a Saxon slave who becomes one of Arthur's most trusted warriors, and ultimately his friend. Arthur, bastard son of Uther and a gifted warlord, is given the task of protecting England until Uther's only legitimate son, Mordred, comes of age. Yet despite his skills in battle, Arthur yearns for peace and a chance to devote himself to his beautiful, clever and duplicitous wife, Guinevere, rather than to warfare. In Enemy of God, Arthur must battle the ever-increasing numbers of Christian subjects who threaten the stability of his land, as well as the Saxon hordes. Meanwhile, the druid Merlin, intent on banishing the Christian God from England, embarks on a quest to return the old Gods of Chaos to power. As Derfel struggles to aid both Merlin and Arthur, Guinevere and the sly, handsome but ultimately cowardly Lancelot plan their own terrible betrayal of their king. Excalibur begins with Arthur a shattered and embittered man, devastated by Guinevere and Lancelot's treachery. While the Saxons unite their warring tribes against Arthur and Derfel, Merlin's mad priestess, Nimue, plots to use Arthur's son and his druid-forged sword, Excalibur, in one last savage attempt to summon the old Gods. Only by making his peace with Guinevere will Arthur find the strength he needs to succeed in his final battle.

There have been countless retellings of the story of King Arthur, and while Bernard Cornwell's trilogy features all the usual characters, he has injected enough originality and suspense into the tale to keep the reader hooked throughout the trilogy.

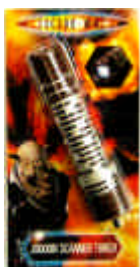


Futurama: Bender Original

Even if Dixon and her team came through themselves with whatever they could carry, the mere creation of steel would take years.

No, if any more people pierced the membrane, they would also be doomed prisoners. And what reason was there to do it? Dixon had her answer. She could go ahead and write a research paper or whatever she did, and bask in the adoration of her peers. Sending more prisoners into exile would surely be prohibited by cost. He was alone. But alone where?

Hunger appended itself to the list of his problems.

When Pearson reached his camp he was still so deep in helpless anger that it took him a few moments to hear the snuffling sound from further down the hill.

His first thought, upon seeing the shuddering orangutan's body, was that it was still alive. He had barely processed the poor logic of this when the other animal stopped feeding on intestines and raised its head.

The size of a large pig, it appeared to be equal parts wombat, koala and bear trap. One beady eye glared at him, the other lost beneath a slash of scar tissue. A throaty sound, like someone trying to start a motorbike, burst from the tangle of teeth. It sprang over the corpse and ran at him.

It may have been protecting its food source or gaining another. Pearson did not stop to find out. His legs were already moving, cured of their fatigue, and he reached full pace by the time his helmet fell to the rocks. He sprinted back toward the gully.

The creature growled again, and the sound of claws thrashing through leaves followed on Pearson's heels until he sprang over a log. The steep hillside, navigated so carefully that morning, passed under him in a series of skids and leaps.

Pearson sprawled on hands and knees on the rocky floor, and pain flared in his knee. A series of limping hops took him to the other side, and he had just started up it when the creature landed at the bottom of the gorge behind him.

Terror rescinded the pain in his knee, and he surged up the slope in a wild scramble. The throaty sound had ceased, but he did not look back until he stood once again at the peak with an ankle-thick branch in his hands.

He was alone.

Pearson stood there for some time, knee and lungs burning, branch following his gaze. When he was satisfied the thing had returned to its meal, he resumed moving in the same direction his flight had taken him.

By morning Pearson could no longer ignore his hunger. Prison, for all its faults, had provided a sufficient quantity of food, and he oscillated between the enjoyment of his newfound freedom and the desire to be back in familiar captivity, with its comparative safety.

A few minutes of turning over rocks yielded a black beetle that glistened with an oil-sheen rainbow, and two flat headed grubs. He weighed them against the pangs in his stomach, then removed the heads and thrust them into his mouth. They tasted faintly nutty.

The following day he came to a slow moving river some eighty meters wide: a long, nervous swim. On the other side the hills began to flatten, and the eucalypts gave way to scrubby head-high bushes. Pearson began a loping run, wincing at every step and grinning like an idiot.

The river appeared to be more than enough to keep the creature away, but he kept exploring. Part of him reveled in the complete lack of boundaries. Something else expected answers over every rise: a group of cavemen, or the ruins of the civilisation he knew. Perhaps he could dance on Dixon's grave.

Instead he found another river, more than three times as wide as the last, and he resolved to try for some fish. The wire in his pocket was pliable enough to twist one end around a stout branch, and formed a simple hook at the other. He found a grub in moments. Two hours' patience yielded a small eel.

Pearson hung his catch from his makeshift pole, slung it over one shoulder and followed the riverbank. His spirits lifted. He had begun to adjust to the rules by which his new environment worked.

The riverbank had become a series of headlands and inlets. Pearson climbed a rocky hill and looked for a place to make a cooking fire. The scene struck him as familiar. Realisation followed like a breaking wave.

He was looking at Sydney Harbour.

"The day I summited Mount Everest was the day I died"

Lincoln Hall set off for Everest in early May 2006. Five weeks after reaching Base Camp in Tibet, he began his push for the summit.

After three days of climbing higher into the oxygenless air, he was blessed with a perfect summit day. For a few minutes, Hall was the highest man on the planet. His Sherpa companions arrived, photos were taken, and the climbers commenced their long descent.

Then things began to go horribly wrong. Hall was struck by cerebral oedema - highaltitude sickness - in the aptly named 'death zone'. Drowsiness quickly became overpowering lethargy, and he collapsed in the snow. Two Sherpas spent hours trying to revive him, but as darkness fell he was pronounced dead. The expedition's leader ordered the Sherpas to descend to save themselves. The news of Hall's death travelled rapidly from mountaineering websites to news media around the world, and by satellite phone to Hall's family in Australia.

Early the next day, Dan Mazur, an American mountaineering guide with two clients and a Sherpa, was startled to find Hall sitting cross-legged on the knife-edged crest of the summit ridge. Hall's first words - 'I imagine you are surprised to see me here' - were a massive understatement.

Much was reported in the press about Hall's resurrection, but only he has real insight into what happened, and how he survived that longest night.
