Dungeons & Dragons 4th Edition + Worldwide D&D Games Day






Book Reviews

The Moneymaker by Janet Gleeson, reviewed by Andrew Wilson

This is more an extended magazine article than a book. However, the subject "John Law" the Scottish economist is enormously interesting. If Terry Pratchett had such a character you would think John Law a bit far fetched.

John Law had an imposing physical presence, an unrufflable geniality and calm disposition. He was also a mathematical genius with the ability to do calculations at lightening speed in his head. His family are goldsmiths and goldsmiths handled the finance markets of the time. Young John learned the family business but was a little bit of a playboy. He killed a man in a duel and had to leave the United Kingdom. After going through his inheritance he decides to make his living at what he loves: Gambling. He had absorbed a work on probability before the science was fully understood and had ice water in his veins. He understood odds better than the casinos and his fellow players and amassed a fortune. John Law then dabbled in the finance market, making himself a considerable fortune.

The nations at the time had a financial problem. All ready money was based on precious metals. Therefore exchange was limited to the coin you can mint. Banks and individuals did use bills of exchange. So John asked himself two questions "Why is a casino chip worth so much and a coin worth so much?" and "If you need money why not just print it?". He was no fool and had learned how the introduction of Spanish silver had inflated the currency. After the wars of Louis XIV, France was in nearly terminal economic decline. Finally after much effort John convinces the Regent for the child King Louis XV that he had an an answer to France's economic problems. He then owns the mint. What follows is described on the back of the book as "General economic theory rewritten by the Marx Brothers."

Calculating God by Robert J Sawyer, reviewed by Jen Temm

Does God exist? Not to Tom Jericho, a terminally ill palaeontologist and lifelong atheist at Toronto's Royal Ontario Museum. But when a giant spider-like alien arrives at the museum to examine earth's evolutionary history to confirm the existence of a creator, all Tom's preconceptions are thrown into doubt.

Calculating God is an intriguing piece of hard sci-fi that delves into metaphysics and philosophy in the tradition of Arthur C Clarke. The science is convincing enough to a dilettante like myself with the author transforming difficult material – palaeontology, genetics, stellar phenomena – into entertaining if lengthy discourse on the nature of God. The narrative is well paced and entertaining, with plenty of contemporary references to science and popular culture. A typical moment is where the alien Hollus complains to Tom about the dearth of scientific information available to his team of fellow travellers snooping on our transmissions: "I know more about your popular music and food-preparation technology than I ever cared to – although I am intrigued by the Popeil Automatic Pasta Maker". The two later watch Star Trek movies and debate the unlikelihood of the inter-species mating that could result in a Spock.

There are some intrinsic flaws, however, that weaken the novel. Like many in this ideas-based genre, Sawyer fails to fully flesh out his characters so the inevitable ending has little impact on an emotional level, while the climax stretches belief to the point where it throws doubt on the whole story. The construction is also flawed: told in the first person from Tom's perspective, it raises the question of how a character we know is about to die can be telling the tale. And while the didactic approach works well – the plot centres on the debates between Hollus and Tom – the only action comes from a completely unnecessary sub-plot involving two rather stupid Creationist and Pro-Life activists.

Calculating God is, nevertheless, thought provoking, engaging and witty, and well worth reading. Canadian author Robert J Sawyer has published some 18 novels and is one of only seven writers to win the Nebula, Hugo and John W Campbell Memorial awards, joining the likes of David Brin, Arthur C Clarke and Joe Haldeman.

The Magic of Recluce by L E Modesitt, reviewed by Stuart Wark

Lerris is the main character in the Magic of Recluse, an individualist growing up on the island of Recluse, a haven of order and conformity. He must undertake a dangergeld, a form of banishment, with another four exiles, until he can reconcile himself with life on the island. He is sent to Candar, a country where Chaos seems to dominate.

Lerris becomes the main, albeit unwilling, protagonist in the battle between Order and Chaos. His journey of self-discovery leads him to assist Candar in defeating the white wizards and saving his fellow exiles. Unlike many 'unknown youngster becomes world's greatest hero' fantasies, Modesitt manages to retain some semblance of believability during Lerris' transformation. Modesitt's interest and knowledge in engineering and science is clear, with both Chaos and Order defined clearly and plausibly within the context of the series. Importantly, the inherent rules of this universe are both rational and credible.

The Magic of Recluse is the first book in the Recluse of Saga that now stretches to twelve volumes. The premise of the saga revolves around the ongoing struggle between the white wizards, masters of Chaos, and the Order masters. Modesitt portrays the battle between good and evil well, utilising the unusual but well conceived concept of magic based upon chaos and order.

Unlike most fantasy series, the Saga of Recluse can be read with no prior knowledge of previous books, with the stories moving back and forth through history and based around different characters. It is very possible to read any novel in the series without needing to be familiar with the previous history. The Saga of Recluse stands up exceptionally well when compared to similar series such as the Wheel of Time or Sword of Truth novels.

In my opinion, Modesitt is one of the leading writers within the fantasy field, and doesn't get the credit or recognition in Australia that his novels deserve.

Infinitas Short Story

Pardon Me, Coming Through By Steven Cavanagh Part Three of Five

Previously: In near-future Sydney, death-rower Chris Pearson has been drawn in the Pardon Lot- if he survives a scientific experiment, he is free. Pearson is dragged into a chamber to become the first human attempt at interdimensional travel.

Pearson's childhood swimming hole was a great rocky pool fed by a short waterfall. The old-growth rainforest bordering his father's farm had been exciting enough, with all the lost civilisations and pirate lairs the child mind could conjure. The swimming hole it concealed was something more, a great glass ocean with the dark promise of eels lurking beneath his feet. His father had called it bottomless. The word stretched beyond depths and fathoms - there was eternity down there.

More than once he tried to find it, legs churning down, down and arms reaching into the blackness. Each time human frailty drove him back up, fear or the need for oxygen. Each time he imagined he had come within a finger length of the bottomless bottom, of being there.

And now he was, in the same darkness with the same desperate lack of breath, and poised in a place where there was no back up to reach for. Sparks, drugs, pixie dust washed through his body. He felt his molecules jostle like balls in a play pit.

His fingers, writhing like eels, tried to grasp his mouth and found a wall around his head. He shook and twisted it, nose and throat burning. A hose snapped and hissed venomous anger. Something in his neck tugged and the helmet came off, pouring vomit.

Pearson coughed for some time.

When a burnt, rotting stench overpowered the bile in his nose, Pearson raised heavy eyelids. He lay on the charred and fly blown corpse of an orangutan, dressed in the same UNA research coveralls he wore.

Pearson reeled back onto one knee.

He knelt on a slope in a forest of ghost-white trees. Ferns poked emerald tongues out of the rocks. Through the trees he could see the sky, a brilliant blue. The sun, comfortingly familiar, could be seen low on the horizon, attended by pink clouds.

Pearson tore off the fist-sized oxygen bottle and seal collar. He lurched away from the corpse and fell to the humus, letting the world spin until his head cleared.

He found the promised metal cylinder eight meters downhill, spared from rolling into a gully by one of the trees. The tree looked similar to a gum, a little small and gnarled. The leaves were streaked grey-blue.

He lifted the resonator upright and sat beside it, staring at the blue button for some time. This looked more like a national park than another dimension. Had he merely moved his location? Or time?

Hit the button and we'll bring you back, they had said. Pearson wasn't that gullible- it had taken a large facility full of equipment to send him here, and this overgrown torch wouldn't reverse the process. If they could bring anything back, they could have sent a probe to record what was on the other side. It was a one-way trip, and he would not do Dixon any favours.

But what if the facility was only a we kilometers away? What if he'd just been drugged and dumped here for the benefit of hidden cameras, like those voyeuristic 3DV shows? He would have failed to fulfill his legal requirements for pardon, and he'd be returned to his cell before his bed had gone cold.

It soon became apparent that he had other priorities. The sun was setting. Pearson cleaned himself as best he could with ferns and limped uphill out of range of the corpse's stench, to where

two trees arced over a hollow. He kicked aside uncomfortable looking rocks.

Nightfall brought new revelations. He could see no glow of city lights and hear no traffic. He heard a lonely, birdlike too-whip in the distance, but could not tell if it was terran or alien. Something thumped its way through the gully, but nothing approached his camp.

For the first time in many years, only freedom lay around him.

He had started to relax when he noticed the stars. He leaped to his feet and stumbled around his camp, looking through several gaps through the trees until he was certain that Scorpio, the Southern Cross and all the constellations he knew were gone.

By morning, a restless night's thinking had borne little fruit. Pearson returned to the cylinder and pressed the button, but it only hummed for two minutes and then fell silent. So was he, for three expectant hours.

Certain now that Dixon had lied to him, he tried to dismantle the cylinder for useful parts, but his most frustrated efforts with a rock left barely a dent in the seamless metal.

His outfit held more promise. The sealing collar contained a coil of thin wire slightly over a meter long, which he pushed into the leg pocket of the coveralls. The bulbous helmet also appeared useful, at least as a water container.

Ready to explore his new prison, he crested the hill and made his way down the other side. The slope grew steep and an easy walk soon became sliding and stumbling on moss and rocks. When he passed into the shadow of the hills it began to grow cooler, and at the bottom the slope dropped into a shallow gorge.

Pearson slid his way down and found, to his relief, a creek picking its way over the rock. The water looked clear and tasted cool. He washed out the helmet and cleaned his throbbing burns, and started up the other side refreshed.

This hill was higher than the other, and took half an hour to climb. At its peak he scaled the largest of the twisted eucalypts. Nothing could be seen in any direction but more forested hills, squashed together like the surface of a moldy brain.

Pearson sat with his back against the tree while the sun crawled overhead. The dull buzz of anonymous insects and a distant too-whip was the only evidence of life. Perhaps all there would ever be.

He found a thin stick, brushed clean a patch of dirt and wrote: PEARSON WAS HERE.

Lame, but it was writing. Communication, even if there were no intelligent eyes to read it. He rubbed at the dirt and tried the look of:
