Book Reviews

***Temeraire (or His Majesty's Dragon)* by Naomi Novik, reviewed by Andrew Wilson**

Naomi Novik has created a world that is both feels real in substance and intriguing to enter. A simple question "How would Napoleonic warfare have looked if both sides had Dragons?" has created an impressive novel. Master and Commander meets Anne McCaffrey.

The initial pages where a British sea captain captures a Dragon's egg, that will become Temeraire, from the French are absolutely first rate. The story moves with great verve and colour.

The Dragon riders area breed apart and joining them involves ostracising yourself from the world. The internal problems of the Captain Will Laurence are finely portrayed. The parts with Captain getting to know the dragon are also good. The dragons themselves are real creatures that come in a variety of breeds. Needless to say Temeraire is exceptional even for these exceptional creatures. Ms Novik's dragons are as good as anything Anne McCaffrey has drawn.

To nitpick; modern attitudes seep into the story. It is best to consider the Dragon riders as a strange sub-set of Regency society and not its core. The dragons and the hard bitten old salt sea Captain, so well drawn generally, occasionally reflect modern sensibilities. The Dragons are at times somewhere between pets, war horses and children. Then you find a dragon actually in a position of authority. A good scene that she shows but hardly indicative of a society that kept slaves (admittedly mostly in the West Indies) and denied women the vote.

Dragons fly because of magic. Getting an unaerodynamic lizard into the air with a crew of what seems to be at least ten is best left unexplained. The writer can't help herself in the time wasting asides on dragon flight. I know some people like this and that it makes it more real for them. However no matter how clever, and this is a clever story, it seems ridiculous to me.

The world is just great and story moves at a very good pace. The writer's vision is strong. The final climatic battle is a great strategic set up for everyone who likes military history, unfortunately, I found its tactical resolution unfulfilling. All that said I couldn't put the book down.

***Soul Eater* by Michelle Paver, reviewed by Josephine Crowley**

Soul eater is book three of this series. The story is of Torak and his pack brother Wolf, and their adventures together with Renn their friend in the cold far north world. It is exciting from the very first page, has action aplenty and will hold the interest of all that read it. Michele Paver has a great gift for story telling. This is written for children and able to be read by anyone of a good reading age. It will hold the interest of anyone with a sense for adventure. As an adult I was enthralled, indeed by the whole series of "chronicles of ancient darkness". I felt friends with wolf and if I were to pat him on the nose he would know and like me. Wolves will never be quite the same to me, and I will look at them differently when I see them next in the zoo.

The galaxy is at war, events are coming to coming to a climax, and the Allied forces are closing in on their over-extended foe. The Allies are desperately trying to understand how the enemy is managing their communications, but the opposition is strong, and effective. Captain Naytan is sent back to his home planet with a combined group of commandos & mercenary elves, but when they arrive, they discover that the Bassarian Empire has overrun all resistance, and is building a superweapon to end the war in their favour. Knowing the planet is about to be bombed to a cinder, Naytan & his troops are working against time & heavy opposition to accomplish their mission, and hopefully, maybe even survive.

Combining a Star Wars style saga with space opera, hi-tech weaponry with bladed combat, killer mystic elves, trolls & a dragon, Milne has written a solid first novel. The combat scenes are well done, and the plot moves along quickly, developing as it goes. In style, reminiscent of Sean McMullen crossed with John Ringo, with a dash of David Weber for seasoning.

Dixon smiled like she was checking her teeth. 'This project, Mister Pearson, is the crowning achievement of this facility and the culmination of decades of research. This is quite a gift horse. Not only will you be a free man, you'll be famous worldwide. You should be excited!'

Excited? Two years ago Dean McNulty, the 'dance floor killer', was drawn in the Pardon Lot to test an Ebola cure. Oops, back to the drawing board. Matt McDonagh's cosmetics tests wouldn't have killed him, but his family exploited the euthanasia loophole, collected the insurance and milked the current affairs circuit.

'Tell you what,' Pearson leaned forward. 'How about we put a bullet in his gun, give it a spin, put it to your head and see how friggish excited you are?'

Her mouth gaped. 'You don't think the system is fair, Mister Pearson? Those before you have been hung, electrocuted and injected with toxins. Today you merely participate in a project, albeit one with some risk, and your debt to society is paid.'

Tec Nechama*Defiance: The Bielski Partisans*

The prevailing image of European Jews during the Holocaust years is one of helpless victims under a death sentence, unable to fight consignment to the ghettos, to the camps, and to the gas chambers. In fact, many Jews struggled alone or with others against the terrors of the Third Reich, risking their lives against overwhelming odds for the slimmest chance of survival, or a mere glimpse of freedom. In *Defiance*, Tec Nechama offers a riveting history of one such group, a forest community in western Belorussia that would number more than 1,200 Jews by 1944--the largest armed rescue operation of Jews by Jews in World War II.

Tec shows that while most forest fighters in Belorussia were rifle-carrying young men, the members of this extraordinary community included both men and women, some with weapons but mostly unarmed, ranging from infants to the elderly. She reconstructs for the first time the amazing details of how these partisans and their families--hungry, exposed to the harsh winter weather, always on the lookout for German patrols--managed not only to survive, but to offer protection to all Jewish fugitives who could find their way to them. Driven by courage born out of despair, they dug wells, set up workshops to repair guns, made clothes, and resoled shoes, supplied services to other guerilla units, and even established a makeshift hospital and school in the forest. Arguing that this success would have been unthinkable without the vision of one man, Tec offers penetrating insight into the group's commander, Tuvia Bielski, and his journey from his life as the son of the only Jewish peasant family in an isolated rural village to his emergence as a leader possessing the charisma and courage to command under all but impossible circumstances. Tec brings to light the untold story of Bielski's struggle as a partisan who lost his parents, wife, and two brothers to the Nazis, yet never wavered in his conviction that it was more important to save one Jew than to kill twenty Germans. She shows how, under Bielski's guidance, the partisans smuggled Jews out of heavily guarded ghettos, scouted the roads for fugitives, and led retaliatory raids against Belorussian peasants who collaborated with the Nazis against their former Jewish neighbors. Refusing to turn away the weak or the old for the sake of the survival of the larger group, Bielski would warn new arrivals to the forest, "Life is difficult, we are in danger all the time, but if we perish, if we die, we die like human beings." A scholar, a writer, and herself a Holocaust survivor, author Tec Nechama devoted the last two decades to studying the fate of European Jewry, recording rare but vital examples of human compassion, resistance, altruism and heroism in the face of overwhelming horror and despair. Drawing on wide-ranging research and never before published interviews with surviving partisans--including Tuvia Bielski himself two weeks before his death in 1987--she reconstructs here the poignant and unforgettable story of those who chose to fight. **\$29.95**

Josef Sepp Allerberger was an Austrian conscript who qualified as a Wehrmacht machine-gunner and was drafted to the Southern sector of the Front in July 1942. Wounded at Voroshilovsk, he experimented so successfully with a captured Russian sniper-rifle while convalescing and returned to his unit as his regiment's only sniper specialist. In the gruelling months that followed, as the German Army was forced to withdraw under almost constant pressure from the Russians, Allerberger became the second most successful German sniper and one of the very few private soldiers to be awarded with the coveted Knights Cross. This harrowing and graphic memoir provides a vivid insight to the atrocious conditions and brutal cruelty of this campaign. There was, we learn, no place for chivalry and few prisoners survived long after capture.
