Duncan Lay Book Launch





Cardinal's Blades by Pierre Pevel reviewed by Jonathan Dean

Remember the Three Musketeers? Gallant, noble swordsmen who fight for the King & Queen, against the evil, manipulating Cardinal Richelieu? This time, Cardinal Richelieu has the Cardinal's Blades, an elite group of swordsman spies, on his side, and he needs them desperately. Europe is in the middle of the Hundred Year War, and France is under threat from Spain. The catch is that dragons are real, ancient & powerful, and they have ambitions. The Spanish crown is controlled by the dragons who want to create a lodge of the Black Claw cult in Paris, so that their power will overwhelm all of Europe. Richelieu's only hope is to bring back Captain La Fargue from forced retirement after he was betrayed, reinstate him and hope that he & his men can succeed where all others have failed. If he has to threaten La Fargue's daughter as the price for bringing back La Fargue, so be it.



Their mission? To identify & eliminate the Black Claw before they can create a group in France, identify & eliminate the traitors to the Crown, rescue prisoners & above all, do what the Cardinal wants, even if he never says what his desires are. A challenging goal, and the price of failure is lethal.

Pevel has created a fascinating world, depicting the streets & alleyways of Paris magnificently, whilst presenting a totally credible picture of the people & the times. Betrayals, assassinations, politics and swordsmanship are blended in a violent, turbulent time, where duels are commonplace, the streets are filthy & polluted, and you can picture yourself sitting in the taverns, with the stench of the streets & people filling your nostrils, as he describes the scene. He describes Paris of the time beautifully, and the people are made real to the reader, until you find yourself following them eagerly, wanting to know what is happening. There are certain factors that modern readers may find challenging, but if you read the Three Musketeers & enjoyed it, you'll love this story.

The Risen Queen is the second book of the Dragon Sword Histories, a new series by Australian Author Duncan Lay. It continues the story of Martil, Karia, Merren and their struggle to save Norstalos from an upcoming invasion from their neighbours and the dreaded fearpriests. The thing that I loved about this and the previous book is the way that the author has written his characters. The interaction between Martil and his 'adopted' daughter Karia is beautiful and a highlight of both books 1 and 2. It has been interesting to read about how Martil struggles with his past, present and future and the manipulation of characters along the way. The one negative thing that I will say about this book / series is that I feel like I'm ticking off boxes on all the components that make a good epic fantasy story – magic sword, dragons, a budding romance, a fight of good against evil etc. However, the interaction between characters and the writing of fight scenes and the journey the characters are taken on more than makes up for this slight blemish. I really enjoyed the emotional ride that these books have taken me on. I am looking forward to the third book coming out to complete the series and then Duncan Lay's future fantasy series to see how he develops and grows as an author in this genre.

If you like epic fantasy like Raymond E Feist, David Eddings etc, then you will enjoy this series. It's great to see an Australian author writing such good quality epic fantasy... there should be more of it!

If you got to know Fforde through his Thursday Next series then Shades of Grey will feel different in a familiar way: instead of literature being all-important it's colour. And it's written by Jasper Fforde, so it was never likely to be a bad book. But Shades of Grey is easily the nastiest book he's given us. There's an oppressive social system, more drama and fewer gags. Even the more sympathetic characters do things that make them hard to like. If you're feeling down and need cheering up, go elsewhere. Otherwise it's recommended.

As we all know, news accounts of the last two wars focused almost exclusively on battlefield imagery of high-tech weapons wreaking astounding destruction, comply with analysis from retired army grandees and other experts, punctuated by the odd heartwarming patriotic sound-bite. The troops themselves play a role in the media's presentation of recent wars rather like extras in The Triumph of the Will. They are everywhere yet somehow invisible. When they speak you get the sense that what they are saying has been carefully scripted. Now GENERATION KILL tells the soldiers' story in their own words.

The narrative focuses on a platoon of 23 marines, many of them veterans of Afghanistan, whose elite reconnaissance unit spearheaded the blitzkrieg on Iraq. This is the story of young men that have been trained to become ruthless killers. It's about surviving death. It's about taking part in a war many questioned before it even began.

Evan Wright was the only reporter with First Recon, which operated well ahead of most other forces, usually behind enemy lines. They were among the first marines sent into the fight and one of the last units still engaged on the outskirts of Iraq, even after the city centre fell. GENERATION KILL is not just a combat chronicle but an inside look at how people fighting in war actually experience it. It is both an action narrative like Black Hawk Down and a detailed portrait of a generation at war along the lines of Band of Brothers.
