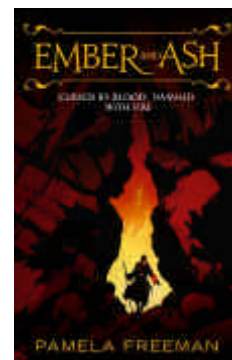
Book Reviews

Ember and Ash by Pamela Freeman, reviewed by Anna

"Ember and Ash" is a fantasy set in the Last Domain of the Eleven Domains. The fantasy setting revolves around the Great Powers: Fire, Water, Air, Earth, Forest and Ice. The book starts off with a disastrous wedding followed by an emotional argument between the protagonist and one of the Great powers, whose consequence is that fires all over the domain are smothered and cannot be re-lit. This being a horrible situation in the cold northern domain, the protagonist Ember, the daughter of the warlord of the Last Domain, is set the task of stealing an ember from the Fire mountain, which is the seat of Fire. There are a few other characters of note: Arvid and Martine (the rulers of the Last domain as well as the parents of Ember), Ash Senior and Ash Junior (the former being favoured of Water, and the latter being a peer of Ember who shares the trials of the journey with her), Cedar (a strange young man with the power of stone-casting), and Elva (Gods-touched, able to speak with the gods and relay their messages to the peoples).



The character development is done beautifully. There is a certain dynamism lacking in the main characters which can be forgiven thanks to the intricate weaving of the story which makes each character perfect for his or her role. Each of them shows sudden out-of-character jumps which can almost be thought as pushing the boundaries, but they go back to their two-dimensional role post the aberration. This was my only complaint with the book. Other than this, the plot is highly developed, and left me waiting to know more. The descriptions are lyrical, and the fantasy setting is amazingly beautiful. Initially, I was a little confused due to the storyline being broken up to follow the paths of four or so characters one after the other. However, it all comes together in a climactic finish and all the loose ends are tightly wrapped up. The whole book sets the heart rate at a little-faster-than-normal pace, the breaths shallow and fast, waiting, waiting, to know what happens at the end. But, unlike some other books where the end is all that matters, the journey through the book is illuminating and leaves the reader with a satisfaction that is hard to deny. I would recommend this book to all fantasy readers out there, with the advice to be patient with the story-line initially. It is definitely worth the read!

A Discovery of Witches by Deborah Harkness, reviewed by Dan

In a world where witches, vampires and daemons live amongst humans, there are rules about mixing with other Creatures. Humans notice the wrongness when there are too many Creatures in one place. When historian Diana Bishop, the last descendant of Bridget Bishop of Salem, calls a lost tome from the Bodleian Library's stacks while researching for a lecture, she finds herself the centre of more attention than she dreamed possible. There is more to the book than meets the eye, and Diana finds herself drawn to it. However, Diana turned her back on her magical heritage as a child, and refuses to give in to the temptation to use it to discover more about the bespelled book. The vampires, witches and daemons of Oxford all turn their focus on her in the hopes of gaining possession of the book, and the secrets it is reputed to hold. With a new-found ally against the witches that have been nagging her since her arrival in Oxford, in the form of Matthew Clairmont (vampire, doctor and scientist), Diana sets out to find out what is in the book and why she is the only one that has summoned it. What follows is a journey of discovery of Creature legend, lore and laws. From the university city of Oxford, to castles in France and magical houses in America, Diana and Matthew's investigations uncover Creature conspiracies and promise to start new ones.



Discovery of Witches is a paranormal romance written with the lush language, settings and style of epic fantasy. Deborah paints her scenes and characters with broad brushstrokes that give the essential details on each person, place or situation, but leaving the space for the reader's imagination to be fully engaged reading between the lines. While definitely a romance, the style is old fashioned and somewhat courtly and proper, rather than brash and forthright. The three primary locations in this novel are each personalities in the tale, and help define the old world feel.

This is a book for someone who enjoys paranormal fiction, but is tired of fang-banger style. Or for those who love epic fantasy and are vampire-curious. This is a book that makes you want more!

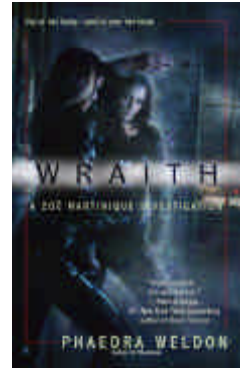
Wraith by Phaedra Weldon, reviewed by Len Newland

Urban spirit-world fantasy. Zoë is an astral traveller using that ability to earn an income as a private detective. This is her first case where she finds spirits involved, which causes problems. The subtitle, *A Zoë Martinique Investigation*, is misleading: the story is about Zoë, not the investigation, as she learns about and develops within author Weldon's spirit world, which is clearly explained to the reader. Also, not stated by the publisher, this book turns out to be just Volume 1 of a serial: it leaves Zoë in deep trouble with incomplete knowledge of the spirit world. I expect she'll learn the rest and come up trumps in later volumes.

Great opening: some books I've reviewed take as much as 30% of the book to introduce it; this one does the job in two pages flat. Zoë's infectious and flippant narrative, particularly her frequent humorous epigrams, then draws the reader on through the story. The novel is exceptional in its portrayal of its leading character: the reader really gets to know and like Zoë. She does suffer learning and planning difficulties, though: her investigating style is like a mosquito merely dodging the swatting hand until its victim falls asleep. By the middle of the book, this is repetitive enough that even Zoë remarks on it ("There's someone here," says yet another character – "No, I'm not!" says Zoë, invisible but audible – "Oops," she thinks, "there goes my big mouth again!"; Weldon's timing of these slips is impeccable). The later stages of the book with people including Zoë getting seriously hurt have a darker tone. Zoë misuses prepositions (had of, hadn't of, inside of, outside of, off of, but oddly no on of); these and other hillbillyisms arguably suit the first person narration of poorly educated Zoë. My only real gripe over this book is with its publisher: some readers like serial novels, but others don't, and I believe publishers should state fairly what they're asking readers to buy.

In all, a well written book that starts like Ray Slattery's humorous novels of Australian soldiers in WWII New Guinea but then takes you down the dark recesses of Weldon's spirit world. I'm sure further entertaining twists await you in the later volumes of this serial.

The 98-gun *Temeraire* warship broke through the French and Spanish line directly astern of Nelson's flagship *Victory* during the Battle of Trafalgar (1805), saving Nelson at a crucial moment in the battle, and, in the words of John Ruskin, fought until her sides ran "wet with the long runlets of English blood...those pale masts that stayed themselves up against the war-ruin, shaking out their ensigns through the thunder, till sail and ensign dropped." The result is a detailed picture of British maritime power at two of its most significant peaks in the age of sail: the climaxes of both the Seven Years' War (1756-63) and the Napoleonic Wars (1798-1815). It covers every aspect of life in the sailing navy, with particular emphasis on amphibious warfare, disease, victualling, blockade, mutiny and, of course, fleet battle, for it was at Trafalgar that the *Temeraire* really won her fame.
