Bitter Greens by Kate Forsyth reviewed by Len Newland

According to the Foreword in this book, the story of Rapunzel was first published in Italy in 1634 by Giambattista Basile, then republished in France in 1698 by Charlotte-Rose de la Force, who according to the Afterword also wrote her own memoirs. Assuming these Words aren't fiction, the book between them is historical fiction with witchcraft magic added to make it a witch fantasy. It comprises a fictional autobiography of de la Force up to her 1697 incarceration in a convent by King Louis IV, interleaved with a long adult story of Rapunzel as supposedly told to de la Force in the convent, and with an autobiography of Rapunzel's witch up to her abduction of Rapunzel. For those who don't remember, Rapunzel is imprisoned in a tower by a witch who accesses her captive by climbing Rapunzel's thirty metres of hair ("Rapunzel, Rapunzel, let down your hair!") until The Hero arrives to climb Rapunzel's hair and destroy the witch. We're told at the start that in this version the witch will be saved, not destroyed. The witchcraft is low level: herbal brews for love, health or poisoning, with some voodoo thrown in (engrave your enemy's name on a candle, seal it in black cloth, smash it to smithereens with a hammer, and bury it in your enemy's garden; convulsive death will occur in three days – I can just hear candle makers sighing, "If only!").



Highlights of the novel include vivid setting descriptions down to botanical detail. The social situation of and restrictions on women in the period are well brought out, which is one of the stated objectives of the novel. The female intrigues in Louis' court are, well, intriguing, although I thought the impacts on de la Force of her various disgraces could have been made clearer. The religious persecutions by the Catholics are very well described; the reader can readily understand the wariness of Catholics by non Catholics that continues to the present day. Other sadisms, not necessarily eradicated today, are well presented; the reader reacts.

The long detailed passages may appeal to readers of literary fiction, and the witchcraft plus plentiful references to sex and nasties of life in the period may appeal to readers of popular fiction, who probably won't be bothered by the average-level English, but overall I found the reading slow. The novel is about de la Force, but autobiography doesn't readily make entertaining story, and here it tends to be overshadowed by the Rapunzel story. One reason might be the long sections of each novel strand between interleaving. Another might be that the de la Force strand darts about all over the timescape; with many incident dates from 1504 to 1697 in the novel and despite those dates being given in chapter headings, I had trouble keeping track of the temporal collage. Finally, the autobiography of the witch seemed to appear from no apparent source for no apparent reason and it finishes hurriedly; it turns out to be necessary for the final resolution, which links the three strands, but until the end I wondered why there were three strands (half way through I had an "oh, don't tell me" reaction; that reaction turned out to be correct, but at the time it was negated by the dates).

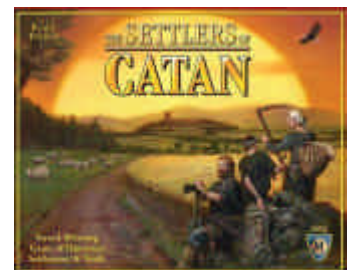
So to read this novel you'll need plenty of time and memory capacity to carry different incidents involving different characters in different social situations at different dates until the collage finally falls into place at the end like a building collapse in reverse. If you have those reading characteristics, you'll be well rewarded with all the benefits I've mentioned above.

Together they hope to rebuild their lives there after Chip, an airline pilot, has to ditch his 70-seat regional jet in Lake Champlain after double engine failure. Unlike the Miracle on the Hudson, however, most of the passengers aboard Flight 1611 die on impact or drown. The body count? Thirty-nine - a coincidence not lost on Chip when he discovers the number of bolts in that basement door. Meanwhile, Emily finds herself wondering about the women in this sparsely populated White Mountain village - self-proclaimed herbalists - and their interest in her fifth-grade daughters. Humphrey Carpenter was given unrestricted access to all Tolkien's papers, and interviewed his friends and family. From these sources he follows the long and painful process of creation that produced The Lord of the Rings and The Silmarillion and offers a wealth of information about the life and work of the twentieth century's most cherished author.
