The Wounded Guardian is a worthy recommendation as a Fathers' Day gift. Although a mainstream fantasy novel in the spirit of David Gemmell, it has as a central theme the parenting of a child. The protagonist is a man with flaws and a dark history who responds to a child in need and ends up raising her from precocious little girl to an empowered adult and major player in the world. This is an escapist adventure where the fantasy setting is alloyed with the truisms and challenges familiar to any father of a daughter.



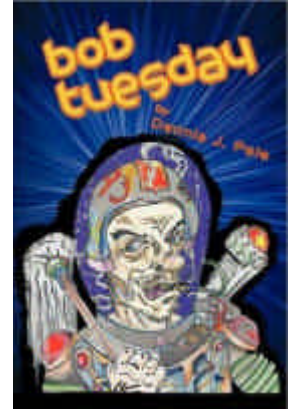

Humorous SF, almost, but not entirely, quite unlike *The Hitchhiker's Guide To The Galaxy*. In a twenty-fourth century human-populated galaxy, Bob is the worst piece of human scum ever born. "And you are cruel towards the guinea pig."; "It bit me!"; "You should not have glued him to the urinal, regardless." You get the idea. We start with Bob's conception, then follow his adventures: a factory planet where child slaves produce stuffed toys used for hard drug smuggling, an enormous slug that farts its way around the galaxy eating planets, and many others (check out the cover blurb).

The novel is humorous throughout, with no coarse words other than "fart". Oddly, it finishes with "To be continued", but it stands alone and is well closed. It has a couple of incidents and some side excursions similar to those in the *Guide*, but the story is different. Bob is said to have the people skills of an Australian football player – author Pale apparently lives west of Sydney, and, like others out there, evidently prefers a game other than the One True Football; there are some other author attitude insertions as well. There is a small amount of Australian idiom that might confuse readers in, for example, America, where the novel was published. I think even a comedy novel would be better without the glitches in English. Point of view switches indiscriminately, although these characters aren't deep. I'd give this novel three stars out of five.

Overall, the novel is quite entertaining. I remember when the *Guide* was the rage, it fascinated teenage boys. I imagine this novel will be as fascinating, and its readers will be pausing from their computer games to text each other their latest discoveries in the book.



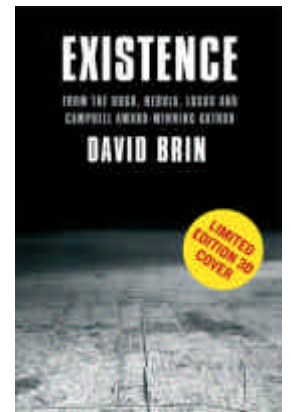

Rarely will I begin a review of any book SF or mundane with the complaint of 'too much imagination', but for this book it is I believe a reasonable suggestion. This is a book about SETI and consequently about Artificial Intelligence. It is set somewhat in the future, where humans are routinely assisted and informed by devices containing Artificial Intelligences. This is necessary as SETI contact is made via the collection from space of a 'rock', which turns out to be a nearly spherical artefact inhabited by the AI versions of Aliens. An Ipad with multiple personalities if you like.

David Brin then proceeds to go to town on the SETI issue, in the way that Isaac Asimov famously explored 'Robotics', leaving few if any unexplored possibilities on the SETI issue. However, this rather thick book also has appearances by uplifted dolphins, and ideas liberally 'borrowed' from Fred Saberhagen's 'Berserker' series as well, what I meant by 'too much imagination'. It is a multi-generational story, with first the discovery of the alien artefact, its interpretation and humanity's reaction to the implications of this discovery, and finally, what humanity chooses to do with this information. After a lengthy process of investigation it turns out that these ovoids are in effect a malign cosmic form of junk mail of the chain letter variety, urging the beings who receive them to 'copy and pass on' the personalities inside the ovoid. The Major downer for me with this book is the cover. It is a concrete grey, with a pasted on 'Three Dee' panel, revealing – a cracked concrete path – or something. Surely some colour would have been better, possibly an 'ovoid from space' featuring an extended alien three fingered hand of welcome, visible from one perspective, could have been permitted? Why is Orion publishing presenting its books like this, it just doesn't say 'Science Fiction' to me.



Conclusion – It is a pretty good book. It deserves to be a Ditmar / Hugo winner, as it contains a series worth of ideas are crammed into one thickish volume. Perhaps it would have been better presented as two or three novels, without the Dolphin stuff and the thoughts of the AI stuff. It is both a novel of ideas and of people's reactions to a form of 'First Contact' and the realization of why we might be alone in the Universe. The 'rise of the AI' isn't that well done and the uplifted dolphin bits just do not seem to be necessary to the greater story. I finished the book having no greater appreciation for the AI issue than after experiencing STNG's Commander Data some decades ago.
