
Once Dead Twice Shy (2009; Book 1 of the series)

Something Deadly This Way Comes (2011; Book 3 of the series)

Urban fantasy aimed at mid-teen girls, featuring angels. There's no hell, but there is a heaven with God surrounded by singing cherubs and seraphs. Into the world are sent Angels called "reapers": grim reapers are mentioned in passing, but here we're concerned with dark reapers, who save a lost soul at the cost of "culling" (killing the body), and light reapers, who save the body in the forlorn hope that the lost soul may "rekindle" (so rare it almost never happens). Note that here light and dark don't equate to good and evil, but the fate-dominated reapers only see black-and-white choices, so it makes sense that they're guided by a light and a dark "timekeeper", both human and thus able to deal with a human world of shades of grey. In this setting, seventeen-year-old Madison discovers that she's fated (from birth) to be the new dark timekeeper, but is given a rather unGodlike lack of instruction on the subject. Consequently, these novels describe her adventures as she (a) discovers how to do the job, and (b) sees that the three-thousand-year-old system doesn't work and needs fixing.

Author Harrison has done a fine job in presenting these novels as a true series and not a serial. They're sequential but self-contained, so you don't have to read them in order or read the lot (they're interesting enough that you probably would). Book 3 has some references to the earlier books, but these are adequately explained within Book 3. While both books I read had closed endings, they left the characters in position for the next adventure in the next novel (Book 2, which I didn't read, is entitled *Early To Death, Early To Rise*; the titles are cute rather than indicating anything). I don't know how many books are in the series, but there's scope for more than three. Oddly, there was an appendix in my copy of Book 3 that's best to read before you start Book 1; it's part of the short story on which the series is based.

I liked the setting, and that it features the moral question of how far you should go with hygiene (don't confuse hygiene with health, which is only one application). In keeping with the target readership, Madison attends high school and disguises the reapers close to her as school mates. There's no outright romance, but Madison does feel good when her favourite boy kisses her. Characters are likeable and their characterisation is well done, except that the dark reaper Nakita appears nice at the beginning of Book 3, which is said to be unusual, but her frictions with the others around Madison would have been better seen (you do see them elsewhere). Madison takes a few bumps, but the main fighting (with divine swords) occurs between reapers, light and dark reapers being in a constant bun fight over who should get the lost soul. The novels are nice length, well paced, and quite readable, my only reservation being average English tending to awkward in places; otherwise the novels tick all the boxes. Four stars out of five for each of them.

Declan, temperamental and protective warlock that he is, doesn't feel so reticent. And when violence erupts again, there's no stopping him from pursuing revenge?

When a council member is murdered in a fashion that screams dark magic, Declan claims someone else beat him to it. Xandra doesn't want to believe he could commit such a brutal act, but she knows he has a dark side - one that his former love interest Tsura understands better than she ever will. With Tsura back in town, Xandra doesn't know whom to trust. And a killer targeting witches and wizards is still at large...
