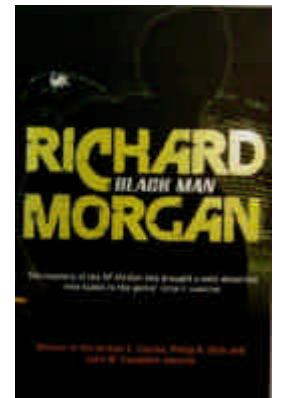
Black Man by **Richard Morgan** reviewed by Len Newland

Manhunt thriller set in 2107. The USA has split into the Union (northeast states), the Rim States, and between them the Confederated Republic ("Jesusland", populated by bible-bashing white supremacist racists); other parts of Earth are also described. Mars is being settled by the Union-based Colony Initiate ("COLIN"), a world power organisation, as is the United Nations. Human variants have been genetically engineered, of which variant thirteen (super soldiers, now disused and held in reservations) is dangerous. In this story, a thirteen (Merrin) escapes from Mars to carry out a murderous escape on Earth, and another thirteen (Marsalis, especially licensed by the UN to catch or kill escapee thirteens) is recruited by COLIN to help stop him.

Author Morgan claims up front to "hate bigotry, cruelty and injustice", and this novel is heavily into criticism of it: even more than Jesuslanders hate black people, they hate supporters of abortion, and more still they hate genetic variants; Marsalis is all three. The cover blurb says the title refers to Marsalis's psyche as well as his skin (that is, arising from his being a thirteen), but I didn't see that within the novel; I thought the title beside the point, and I've heard that the US edition is retitled (I read a British edition dated 2007). The story line is solid, though: there are reasons for Merris's escape from Mars and for the subsequent spate of killings; Marsalis has to use his head to determine these reasons and get to the bottom of the full plot. The background is solid, as well: Morgan has clearly put much effort into designing it, and it addresses many issues besides bigotry. I particularly liked the technology descriptions, such as the virtual-reality forensic reconstructions.

At 630 pages, though, I found this a long and slow novel, and I thought it bloated: much of the writing seemed irrelevant or only incidental to the story line. Considering the other literary shortfalls as well, many common to current thriller novels, it appears this novel is aimed at what I've heard referred to as the Airport Lounge market. This is a pity, because I thought both the story and the setting worth a broader readership. Notwithstanding that, four previous novels by the same author and several notable awards to him as well say that plenty of readers will enjoy the novel.

Masks, the first novel in a mesmerizing new fantasy series, draws readers into a world in which cataclysmic events have left the Autarchy of Aygrima - the one land blessed with magical resources?cut off from its former trading partners across the waters, not knowing if any of those distant peoples still live. Yet under the rule of the Autarch, Aygrima survives. And thanks to the creation of the Masks and the vigilance of the Autarch's Watchers, no one can threaten the security of the empire.

In Aygrima, magic is a Gift possessed from birth by a very small percentage of the population, with the Autarch himself the most powerful magic worker of all. Only the long-vanquished Lady of Pain and Fire had been able to challenge his rule.

At the age of fifteen, citizens are recognized as adults and must don the spell-infused Masks - which denote both status and profession - whenever they are in public. To maintain the secure rule of the kingdom, the Masks are magically crafted to reveal any treasonous thoughts or actions. And once such betrayals are exposed, the Watchers are there to enforce the law.

Mara Holdfast, daughter of the Autarch's Master Maskmaker, is fast approaching her fifteenth birthday and her all-important Masking ceremony. Her father himself has been working behind closed doors to create Mara's Mask. Once the ceremony is done, she will take her place as an adult, and Gifted with the same magical abilities as her father, she will also claim her rightful place as his apprentice.

But on the day of her Masking something goes horribly wrong, and instead of celebrating, Mara is torn away from her parents, imprisoned, and consigned to a wagon bound for the mines. Is it because she didn't turn the unMasked boy she discovered over to the Night Watchers? Or is it because she's lied about her Gift, claiming she can only see one color of magic, when in truth she can see them all, just as she could when she was a young child?
