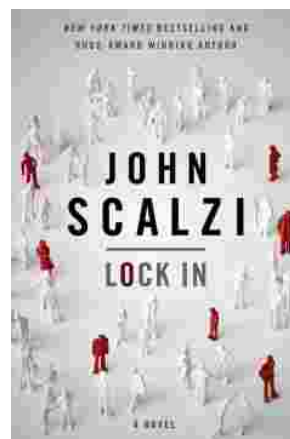
Book Reviews

Lock In by John Scalzi, reviewed by Len Newland

Science fiction of the near-future technology type. The title refers to complete paralysis from a new meningitis-like viral disease, the millions of sufferers being called “Hadens”. An artificial neural network implanted in a sufferer’s brain enables the Haden to use a robot-like prosthetic body (a “threep”) to lead a reasonably normal life while the real body is in nursing care; expensive, so the neural network, its software, the threep, and the nursing are heavily government-subsidised. A few people, also fitted with neural networks in their brains and called “Integrators”, hire themselves out for rich Hadens to use instead of threeps. First person Shane is a Haden who takes the unusual job of FBI agent in a unit specialising in cases involving Hadens and Integrators. Here in his first case, he and his experienced partner Vann, a former Integrator, are presented with an Integrator found with a bloody corpse, and this Integrator “doesn’t think” he did it. Then develops a trail of murder and corporate intrigue spurred by a new law slashing the government subsidies.



Full marks to author Scalzi for versatility: previous novels of his I’ve read are tongue-in-cheek or biff-bash light reading, while this one is a more serious look at a possible application of computer technology and what can go wrong with it, or be made to go wrong with it. The technology descriptions are understandable, with no technocrap (pretentious undefined technical-sounding words). I also found the novel comfortable as a detective story. Isaac Asimov (who also wrote SF mysteries) once said that a good SF story highlights human inanity without resolving it, and Scalzi follows that recipe here with heated debate between characters on whether Hadens are disease victims or a new human race, and also with clashes between those supporting the new law and those regarding it as oppressive to Hadens.

The novel also contains some author insertion in political views having nothing to do with the story (here pro homosexual and anti tobacco-smokers), albeit not enough to turn the novel into a political pamphlet. Scalzi’s English errors don’t usually bother me, but here I did find some of his number mismatches irritating. So three stars rather than my usual five. Characters and their utterances don’t seem different from those in other Scalzi novels, but the trail of murder and intrigue is of solid interest. The main mystery is solved and justice done, and two questions remain unanswered: why is Trinh so obnoxious, and why did Vann’s previous partner commit suicide? Not a bad way to leave a novel.

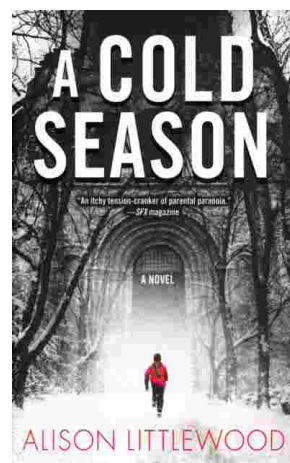
A Cold Season by Alison Littlewood, reviewed by Len Newland

An English widow takes her young son to an isolated village to start a new life, but people there aren’t what they seem. This stand alone novel is a Satan dark fantasy in suspense style.

Mortals can’t beat Satan, so the victory in the end is hollow: the sacrifice achieves nothing and the characters end worse off than they start. The novel focusses on the widow’s ineptitude as a mother and the psychological damage done to her by her father’s treatment of her as a girl. This depiction of the widow didn’t gain my sympathy, although I did see justification for her father’s behaviour when it was finally explained.

The genre isn’t clear at the start, and even a third of the way in, the novel could have been a mainstream story of a widow finding her feet or of English village life, a murder mystery, a psycho drama, a ghost fantasy, a witch fantasy, or a vampire fantasy. Satan didn’t show as such until the last quarter, which is where the interest is. Grammatical errors aren’t prominent, but the reading is confounded by awkward expression and information delayed beyond where it’s needed. I’d give this novel one star out of five for writing quality.



The cover blurb on my review copy invites comparison with Rosemary’s Baby, another Satan dark fantasy. I see parallels, not least that it’s as slow to get to the point. If you enjoy one, you should enjoy the other, and you’ll find what Satan is doing in this novel interesting.

The Edge of Night by David Farmer

‘Good morning!’ said a cheerful voice. I looked up from the garden and stared at the alien. He was standing on the footpath, but the sun was behind him, just above the horizon, and I couldn’t see his face against the glare.

‘Good morning,’ I answered, carefully. I stood up, dropping the weeds onto the grass beside me, and tried to get a look at him. He stepped closer and said: ‘It’s going to be a beautiful day, isn’t it?’ I saw his face was old and tanned and lined, and his hair was greying and sparse. He looked perfectly human. He started to reach out his hand, and then changed his mind.

‘It might rain,’ I said, humouring him. He looked doubtful, and the facial expression worked perfectly. ‘They look just like us.’ That’s what they say on the internet. ‘You can’t tell the difference. They take people away, and we don’t know what happens to them.’

He shrugged, and the gesture seemed human. His clothes were old, and suited him, as if they had all aged together. And he seemed uncontrollably happy, as if my glum mood couldn’t affect him. It must be our sun on his back, I thought. He’s not used to feeling this good. Vacuum of space and all. ‘Well, anyway,’ he rambled on and grinned, ‘I’m not from round here.’

‘I know.’

He stopped. Then he said: ‘And I was wondering if you had any good places to have breakfast here.’ His conversation was the same, but he had changed. There was something about his eyes, something too slow, too watchful to be human.

I could feel the sweat trickle down the back of my neck, but I also felt a chill, in the air around me. Had he noticed it?

I swallowed, and tried to sound cheerful. ‘Well, there’s a few cafes down the road. There’s good ones on both sides of the street. Let me go through them one by one.’ But it was too late. The eyes were more watchful, more alien than ever.

‘How did you know?’ The words came slowly, carefully, utterly different to the way he’d been speaking.

I knew I had to say something, keep him talking, keep him wondering how I knew, for just a little bit longer. Someone might come along. But I could barely speak.

‘Why did you choose here?’ I rasped.

‘Anywhere would do,’ he said, in that cold, careful voice. ‘Anywhere there are people, and sunlight. I looked for the edge of night, for the place where morning had come, nice and early. I have the whole day, to study, and hunt ...’ He paused, as if translating a difficult concept. ‘And feed,’ he finished.

His face froze, and he looked around slowly. He had noticed something was wrong, and it took a whole minute for him to work out what it was. Then he turned and stared at me as he realised he’d given himself away with the very first thing he had said. But he could barely move, and he kept staring in fright, as the day that he thought was beginning, slowly ended. After a few more minutes he lost his balance and fell backward and crunched on the concrete footpath. He rested there like a statue, his arms and legs frozen in place as if he was walking, as the night slowly fell around him.

He had looked for the edge of night, for the place where morning had come, nice and early. But he hadn’t noticed the planet spun the other way. I shuddered. Was he that hungry?

In G. T. Nineteen-year-old Alix Nico, code-named Scarlet, is a kick-ass superheroine with killer Mods and an attitude to match. She's considered one of America's top Levels, even though her last mission nearly precipitated World War III. So now Scarlet and her new partner, Darwin, have been sent to Greater Germany to help sow the seeds of anarchy and prevent Germany's defection to Russia and China.

But where Scarlet goes, chaos follows - and when her mission takes an unexpected turn, she and Darwin must go ever deeper into enemy territory. As Scarlet grapples with a troubling attraction to her new partner, explosive information comes to light about the German cloning program and one of its prisoners - a legendary American Level who just happens to be Scarlet's father.

Unfortunately, she's crushing hard on the totally hot pure-blood Aiden. But falling for Aiden isn't her biggest problem - staying alive long enough to graduate the *Covenant* and become a Sentinel is. If she fails in her duty, she faces a future worse than death or slavery: being turned into a daimon, and being hunted by Aiden. And that would kind of suck.

Masks, the first novel in a mesmerizing new fantasy series, draws readers into a world in which cataclysmic events have left the Autarchy of Aygrima—the one land blessed with magical resources—cut off from its former trading partners across the waters, not knowing if any of those distant peoples still live. Yet under the rule of the Autarch, Aygrima survives. And thanks to the creation of the Masks and the vigilance of the Autarch's Watchers, no one can threaten the security of the empire.

In Aygrima, magic is a Gift possessed from birth by a very small percentage of the population, with the Autarch himself the most powerful magic worker of all. Only the long-vanquished Lady of Pain and Fire had been able to challenge his rule.

At the age of fifteen, citizens are recognized as adults and must don the spell-infused Masks—which denote both status and profession—whenever they are in public. To maintain the secure rule of the kingdom, the Masks are magically crafted to reveal any treasonous thoughts or actions. And once such betrayals are exposed, the Watchers are there to enforce the law.

Mara Holdfast, daughter of the Autarch's Master Maskmaker, is fast approaching her fifteenth birthday and her all-important Masking ceremony. Her father himself has been working behind closed doors to create Mara's Mask. Once the ceremony is done, she will take her place as an adult, and Gifted with the same magical abilities as her father, she will also claim her rightful place as his apprentice.

But on the day of her Masking something goes horribly wrong, and instead of celebrating, Mara is torn away from her parents, imprisoned, and consigned to a wagon bound for the mines. Is it because she didn't turn the unMasked boy she discovered over to the Night Watchers? Or is it because she's lied about her Gift, claiming she can only see one color of magic, when in truth she can see them all, just as she could when she was a young child?

Whatever the reason, her Mask has labeled her a traitor and now she has lost everything, doomed to slavery in the mines until she dies. And not even her Gift can show Mara the future that awaits her—a future that may see her freed to aid a rebel cause, forced to become a puppet of the Autarch, or transformed into a force as dangerous to her world as the legendary Lady of Pain and Fire.
