Orbit by John J. Nance, reviewed by David Bofinger

In most science fiction stories the spaceship is a plot device, taking the characters from A to B and keeping its mouth shut about the details of its job. This isn't one of those stories. The detailed description of space travel procedures bears witness to Nance's background as air force pilot and aviation analyst. (His political leanings are fairly visible too.) There's a realistic space travel tradition stretching back through Clarke to Verne, and this is a fairly standard addition to it.

And then, two-fifths of the way in, it isn't.

I found the change in tone a pleasant surprise. It can be a pleasant surprise for you, too, as long as you don't do something foolish like read the back cover. There's still space travel stuff, but mostly it's character-driven and emotional.

From the preface it seems like Nance usually just does the aviation stuff and is trying something new with *Orbit*. If so, it's an encouraging evolution in his writing. I wouldn't want to read a novel like this every week, but I liked reading this one.

This is book two of the "Godspeaker" series. It is the story Rhian and her battles to claim her inheritance and become queen of Ethrea. Book one, which I also reviewed, I found very bloody and cruel and at times quite evil, but it is important to read book one, *Empress of Mijik*, first. Of course these two books are connected but that connection does not become apparent until well into the story.

I really, REALLY, enjoyed the *Riven Kingdom*. It is not as bloody, gory and cruel as book one. Princess Rhian is a loveable and kind girl, and with her chief off-siders, Jones, Ursa and Zandaka adventure ensues. This book at times makes an exciting and very tense read.

Once again Karen Miller has written a well constructed story. She has the ability to pull you right into the story as if one were really present and part of the story. Congratulations Karen, readers will enjoy this series.

Grieve is a troll and a thief made to break into the Portal and snoop around. The very next day the Shimmer goes missing from the Portal. Grieve is hauled before the Guild, who send Grieve to steal back the Shimmer. Grieve's first, and biggest problem is he needs to find someone who can touch the Shimmer without being turned to dust. That means he needs to find a human - a magic-less and dim-witted race that don't know anything about the real world.

Colin Bundle is an average boy, his mother has died and his father can't cook spaghetti. Colin is scared by the sounds outside and finds Grieve in his bedroom. Grieve needs Colin and he doesn't have time tell him: why he is in Colin's bedroom; why there are two ogres outside Colin's window; or that trolls, ogres and other mythical creatures really do exist. It's all up to Grieve. Can he; stop the fairies; steal the Shimmer back; save Colin and get them both out of Hags End alive?

Shimmer is an easy to read children's book with a good if simple plot. The story flows well and is full of light humour and bumbling heroes. It is a story for the liker of non traditional fairy tales where trolls are the good guys and fairies are four inch tall psychotic bad guys, who want to take over the world. A great book to start a young child on fantasy or for the adult who wants a light read to suspend their disbelief. Even as a children's book it will leave the adult reader waiting for the next instalment of Grieve and Colin's adventures.

In 1916, Airman Joe Bull was posted from Australia to 1 Squadron, Australian Flying Corps, in the Mediterranean campaign. Joe Bull maintained an accurate diary of events until his return to Australia in 1919. He also bought a camera when on leave in Cairo, and with it recorded the people, places and events in the life of 1 Squadron AFC. Joe returned to Australia in 1919, with diaries and photographs intact.

Mark Iax has edited the diaries and woven into the pages confirmatory detail from Australian, British and German records, combined with a selected number of Joe Bull's previously unpublished photos, to present a unique account of 1 Squadron AFC at war. Joe was even able to take his camera into the air and photograph the camp. Other photos include the squadron aircraft, in good condition and after crashes, and captured German aircraft before and after their markings were changed. Joe's diary-keeping was, in some details, better than the official squadron records.

At one time, Joe Bull was a member of the groundcrew for "Captain Smith", later to be one of the Smith brothers, Ross and Keith, who achieved fame by making the first flight to Australia. Photos of squadron personnel include that of Hudson Fysh, later co-founder of Qantas.

Before World War 2, Australia's aviation links to Europe followed the islands to the north, to Singapore, Burma, India and then to England. When the Japanese occupied the northern islands in 1942, the only air route available was from West Australia across the Indian Ocean to Ceylon (Sri Lanka) and India. Even this route was subject to air blockade by the Japanese. The only suitable available aircraft was the Consolidated PBY Catalina.

Qantas and the RAAF combined to establish what was then the longest regular oversea air route in the world. The flight took between 28 and 32 hours, all at 2,000 feet, through all weathers and through the Japanese blockade. The air service had to be kept secret, to preclude Japanese interception and destruction of the unarmed aircraft and passengers.

Only seven passengers could be carried. Navigation of the highest standard was mandatory, as there was no room for error. Navigation aids as known today were non-existent. When the Catalina left base it was alone, out of touch with higher headquarters and with very little chance of rescue if disaster struck.

Arthur Leebold, himself a RAAF WW2 Lancaster pilot, has thoroughly researched this air service and presented an interesting account of the trials and tribulations, and humorous incidents, which befell the aircraft, crews and passengers.

Details of all Catalinas and the flight crews are included.

The book also describes the later services on this route with Liberators, Lancastrians and propjet and jet airliners, providing a contrast between the pioneers and modern flying services. **HC \$24.95**

Four Aces

NICKY BARR flew P-40 Tomahawks and Kittyhawks with 3 Squadron RAAF in the Desert Campaigns 1941-42. A member of the last 'standard' RAAF cadet course in 1941, Nicky graduated as a pilot and arrived at 3 Squadron in November 1941. He was one of those people who seem to attract action, and was in combats almost from his first operational sortie. The offensives and retreats surged back and forth across the North African coastline, and such was the pressure of events that in May 1942 Nicky was the Commanding Officer of 3 Squadron, which he led during an intensive period of ground attack sorties. Nicky destroyed 12 German and Italian aircraft, was shot down several times, and on the last occasion was captured suffering burns. He survived the transit to Italy, and escaped several times, despite rough handling from the SS on re-capture, and later worked with the guerrillas and Allied special forces before returning to Allied lines in Italy. Appendices list text of medal citations, aircraft details and victories, and a nominal roll of 31 Cadet Course, with the fate on active service of each man.

The Spitfire Ace HUGO ARMSTRONG came from a well-known Perth family, and was a member of the first course of trainees to go through the programme of the Empire Air Training Scheme (EATS). Hugo was commissioned on course, graduated in January 1941 and by September was in England, flying Spitfires, and with his first victory. Hugo continued to claim victories and was promoted through command levels to squadron command in nine months, after a medical operation becoming CO of 611 Squadron RAF in September 1942.

Hugo flew on many of the successful sweeps over France, during the Channel Dash by the German battle cruisers from Brest to the Baltic, and as escort to the early US B-17 and B-24 raids. One victory was the expert who was teaching JG26 to fly the FW190, and another was the 900th victory claimed by an aircraft operating from Biggin Hill. Hugo was also successful against the low-level Luftwaffe raiders against the southeast coast of England. Appendices include text of citations, aircraft detail and victories, and a nominal roll of the EATS course, with fate of each man included.

The Mosquito Crew PETER PANITZ and DICKIE WILLIAMS were a successful crew on Mosquitoes on 456 Squadron RAAF, flying Intruder operations hunting trains, aircraft and ground targets low level at night in Occupied France and on Ranger operations hunting aircraft over the Bay of Biscay. After a rest from operations, they returned as a crew to lead 464 Squadron RAAF after the Normandy invasion. Here targets included a Gestapo or SS barracks, and night strikes against SS panzers in the Normandy battle area, all at low level in a hostile environment. Losses were continuous and heavy. Panitz and Williams were lost on one low level strike, and are buried in France. **HC \$24.95**
