Little Brother by Cory Doctorow, reviewed by Adam Moszt

Little Brother is a science fiction novel about the real world we live in. Akin to Orwell's *Nineteen Eighty-Four* in theme and content, it paints a dystopian picture of the near future, and the dark possibilities inherent in it. *Little Brother* is about power, tyranny and corruption. Cory Doctorow, *Little Brother*'s author, vividly renders a stark, not-too-far off world, accurately describing technologies and methodologies used both by the government to control the population, and by the rebels to combat the grip of the politicians.

Little Brother is in itself quite a scary book. It delves into topics such as the total loss of privacy, thought-crime, terrorism, abuses of power and authority, torture, and the treating of citizens as enemies. These are all depicted realistically, and with much political and social background. What makes the book truly frightening on a completely new level is the fact that already, events depicted in *Little Brother* are occurring in the real world. Doctorow has accurately and comprehensively hit a great many nails on the head with his latest book.

Reading *Little Brother* is liable to make the reader at least somewhat paranoid, and drive them to look into certain defensive technologies described and used within the book. They nearly all exist, and work as advertised. Doctorow explains the workings of technology in a way that is easy for the uninitiated to understand, and will have experts nodding in agreement. Disturbingly, the technologies described that invade privacy and steal information are also real, exist, and are used by certain governments and/or people.

The story is written in the fashion of *Starship Troopers* by Robert A. Heinlein. The narration of the "action" is frequently intercut with moral and philosophical discussions which provide insight into the actions of the characters around that point in the story. This technique is not used in a disruptive way, and doesn't jar with the faster paced sequences, but enables the reader to experience a steadily changing variety of pacing without being overwhelmed by any particular one. Doctorow has an easy, understandable, highly readable style of writing that is never likely to force the reader to revisit sentences to glean their meaning.


Unfortunately though, there are some distasteful aspects of the book. Orwell and Heinlein manage to convey their beliefs in fairly culture non-specific settings, allowing the reader to imagine the societies depicted, rather than forcing the settings on the reader. *Little Brother* eventually comes across as aggressively American. The beginning is largely spared from this label. Later on, there is much discussion about "liberties", the "constitution", "amendments", "rights conferred by the Founding Fathers" and the like. It eventually grows tiresome to have the same pro-American propaganda shoved down one's metaphorical throat repeatedly.

Furthermore, the book is dedicated to Doctorow's "tiny baby girl", and "for all the children..." Doctorow seems to have been a bit confused about exactly what age of reader his book is aimed at. On one hand, the themes and issues at hand are sometimes presented in a vulgarly obvious manner, with characters expostulating on how "they" are "taking away our privacy and freedom". On the other, he deals with issues such as teen-age (and in America's case, illegal) drinking, drug use, and sex. Not only does he deal with them, but glorifies them. The narrator, a seventeen year old boy, likes being drunk, claims that eating hash-cookies is fun, and once has sex explicitly with his same aged girlfriend (with other times implied). While standing up for one's rights and fighting for them when necessary is certainly an admirable trait to teach children, some readers may find the above mentioned aspects encourage them *not* to purchase the book for their "tiny baby" impressionable children.

Because Doctorow relies on such a detailed portrayal of the modern world to build the setting for his story, readers who pick up the book in several years will undoubtedly find the terminology and products presented painfully out-of date. Orwell and Heinlein managed to portray worlds that could nearly be any time and any place, securing them the status of timeless classics. Doctorow has gone for a more immediate here and now approach, which lends the book much more gravitas if readers are to pick up the book and read it *now*, as all the places, products and methods are currently being employed. Unfortunately, *Little Brother* will either have to be updated periodically, or will quickly become a relic of yesterday.

Finally, Doctorow seems to go out of his way at several points in the story to bash certain products/companies. Some readers may find that this adds to the realism inherent in the book, others may find it annoying to be subjected to this form of "anti-advertising".

All in all, *Little Brother* is an excellent read, both in terms of an enjoyable, contemporary story and as a wakeup and call to arms in the battle for privacy and freedom of thought, speech and action.

***The Tales of Beedle the Bard* by J K Rowling, reviewed by Sue W**

This book is a companion book to the "Harry Potter" series of seven books written by J K Rowling. Although it works to some extent as a stand-alone book for the reader of any of the "Harry Potter" series, it will not really make sense without having first read the seventh and final book in the series, "Harry Potter & the Deathly Hallows" (HPDH hereafter for convenience).



"The Tales of Beedle the Bard" gets its first mention in HPDH as a children's book of fairy tales for magical children, and is as well known to them as tales such as "Cinderella" and "Ali Baba & the 40 Thieves" are to we "Muggles" ie non-magical folk. However, only one story is relevant to the plot of HPDH, this being "The Tale of the Three Brothers" which describes how three brothers are given gifts by Death himself, and how they use them and ultimately meet Death again. The point of that story in HPDH was that it was in fact a true story disguised as a fairy tale, and that the three objects, or "hallows", being a powerful wand, a Resurrection Stone to being back the dead, and a powerful Invisibility Cloak, in actual fact existed.

The book includes notes on each story written by Albus Dumbledore, the Headmaster of Harry Potter's magical school Hogwarts for most of the HP series. The five stories are short, to the point, and have parallels in Biblical parables, in that there is always a moral "point". Dumbledore discusses the meaning of each story, and for the reader of the HP series, this commentary is perhaps more interesting and relevant than the stories themselves. In particular the commentary on "The Tale of the Three Brothers" is interesting to devoted HP fans more for what isn't said than what is said. Dumbledore discusses the possibility that the three objects exist, but seems to discount it. In fact readers of HPDH know that he already owned the Elder Wand, knew that Harry Potter's invisibility cloak was almost certainly the real one, and was on the trail of the resurrection stone, at the time he wrote this commentary. However, in HPDH we discover that he has come to realise the dangers involved in seeking these "Hallows", and therefore would not want to encourage others to do so.

A point of interest is that J K Rowling herself did the illustrations for the book, displaying a hitherto (to me) unsuspected talent - not having read the other two companion books, "Quidditch Through the Ages" and "Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them" yet, I don't know if she also illustrated those books.

As a stand-alone book, "The tales of Beedle the Bard" works - just - owing to some of the footnotes in the Dumbledore commentary designed to explain certain terms to "Muggle" readers, but it's true worth is to round out the final story in the HP series for genuine HP fans. Like most of the HP books, it seems to be superficially aimed at young readers, albeit with some unpleasant and violent stories - but no more so than some conventional fairy tales - think of Hansel & Gretel burning alive an old witch. However, the further into the HP series you read, the more the books seems to be aimed at an older audience. While the same theme is indicated here, especially in the Dumbledore commentary, adult readers would find this book of minimal interest unless (like me) they have read and devoured all seven HP books. To me, rather than being of any great interest in itself, it's value lies in fleshing out the final HP story.

But for genuine HP fans, it's a definite must-have to round out the collection.
